

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How to access transaffirmative surgeries as a refugee or immigrant in Montreal










E.g. vaginoplasty, phalloplasty, mastectomy. Others, like breast reduction and breast augmentation are not covered.

If you have **IFHP**, generally surgeries are not covered but **GRS** (surgery center) may ask for an exception with the provider. **IFHP** covers hysterectomy. If you can pay, GRS will accept your money.







PREP IS A MEDICATION THAT
SERONEGATIVE PEOPLE TAKE
BEFORE SEXUAL RELATIONS IN
ORDER TO PREVENT HIV
TRANSMISSION.

IT'S EFFECTIVE TO PREVENT HIV
TRANSMISSION, BUT NOT OTHER
SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED
INFECTIONS (STI).



FOR LGBTQ+ IMMIGRANTS AND REFUGES IN MONTREAL



IF YOU HAUE IFHP

DID YOU KNOW THAT REFUGEE CLAIMANT INSURANCE (INTERIM FEDERAL HEALTH PROGRAM IFHP*) COVERS THERAPY IF YOU HAVE A GENERAL DOCTOR'S PRESCRIPTION FOR PSYCHOTHERAPY? THE PRESCRIPTION NEEDS TO INCLUDE A DIAGNOSIS.

HERE'S A LIST OF MEDICAL CLINICS THAT ACCEPT **IFHP** WHERE YOU CAN ASK FOR A PRESCRIPTION:

*In Canada, the IFHP offers brief health coverage to resettled refugees, refugee claimants, in-Canada-protected persons, and specific other groups.
